WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate Sri G Anandam presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the 4th Respondent contained in Notice bearing Rc.NO. A/7035/2016-5, dated 30-5-2022, in referring the claim relating to payment of compensation for acquisition of the land in Sy. No.387/E1; 387/E4; 387/E5 and 387/A1, admeasuring to an extent of Ac. 1-33 1/2 Guntas, 0-37 1/2 Guntas, 0-37 1/2 guntas, and Ac. 4-00 Guntas, respectively situated at Indaram Village and Gram Panchayat, Jaipur Mandal, now under Mancherial District, U/S 77(2) read with Section 37(2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (hereinafter referred to as "The RFCTLARR Act") to the Respondent No.2, based on the untenable and frivolous objection raised by 6th Respondent, in spite of rejecting the objection raised by Respondent No.6, by order 31-12-2020, passed by the 4th Respondent, as illegal, arbitrary, unreasonable, unjust, unconstitutional, contrary to the provisions of The RFCLARR Act, besides, being in violation of Fundamental and Constitutional Rights guaranteed under Article 14, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently set

aside the reference Notice 30-05-2022 and direct the respondents to pay compensation to the petitioner in respect of acquisition of the above said lands along with interest as contemplated u/s 80 of the RFCLARR Act;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri G ANANDAM Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Land Acquisition for respondent No.1 to 5, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
