ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for Revenue for respondent Nos.1 to 4. With their consent, the Writ Petition is disposed of at the admission stage.

In this writ petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to the respondent No. 4 to conduct de novo enquiry in respect of land in Sy. No. 246 to an extent of Ac.8-02 guntas, Kondapur Village of Medipalli Mandal, Jagityal District in pursuance of the directions of the respondent No. 2 and in turn, seeks a direction to the respondent No. 2 to take necessary action for issuance of Pattadar Pass Book and Title Deed to the petitioner for an extent of Ac.3-08 guntas in Sy. No. 246, Kondapur Village of Medipalli Mandal, Jagityal District.

Having regard to the letter dated Nil, issued by the respondent No. 2 directing the respondent No. 4 to conduct survey of the subject land and submit a report, without going into the merits or demerits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent No. 4 to act upon the letter of the respondent No. 2 and conduct the survey of the subject land and submit a report to the respondent No. 2. Before conducting the survey, the respondent No. 4 shall put on notice the petitioner and all the interested parties and submit his report to the respondent No. 2, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

The miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
