Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the high handed action and unlawful interference of the 3rd respondent/ Jaipur (Law as Order) Police Station, Mancherial District in preventing the petitioner from entering into the property in Sy.No. 176/69 (wrongly shown as 176/13 in online records) to an extent of Ac.3.00 gts situated at Gangipally Village, Jaipur Mandal, Mancherial District inspite of a decree dated 15-03-2021 made in O.S.No. 13/2019 on the file of Junior Civil Judge at Chennur, at the behest and with aid and assistance of 4th to 6th respondents

unlawfully, and directing to hand over the possession to the unofficial respondents failing which he will continue to register crimes against the husband and the family members of the petitioner as wholly illegal, arbitrary, violative of Article 14, 19, 300-A of constitution of India, as well Human rights, and consequently direct the 3rd Respondent not to interfere with the enjoyment of the aforementioned property.

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed seeking a *mandamus* to declare the highhanded action and unlawful interference of the 3rd respondent police in preventing the petitioner from entering into the property in Survey No.176/69 to an extent of Ac.3.00 guntas, situated at Gangipally Village of Jaipur Mandal, Mancherial District, in spite of decree dated 15.03.2021 passed in O.S.No.13 of 2019 on the file of the Junior Civil Judge, Chennur, as illegal and arbitrary.

2. Sri S.Rama Mohan Rao, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, on instructions, submitted that case and counter-case are registered and the police are conducting investigation. Except conducting investigation in the crimes, the respondent police neither interfered nor prevented the petitioner from entering into the subject property.

3. Recording the submission of learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No order as to costs.
