WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate SRI MEKAPOTHULA SRINIVASA RAO presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus by declaring the action of the respondent in not permitting the petitioners to writ M.D. (DVL) examination to be held from 16.05.2022 to 23.05.2022 and also practical/clinical and Viva Examination is unsustainable in law, illegal, arbitrary and consequently direct the respondent university to receive the examination fee, issue hall ticket to the petitioners and allow the petitioners to appear for the examination along with other students who are appearing for PGMD (DVL) the examination and further direct the first respondent university to declare the results as and when the results are declared for all the students by the University and permit her to complete the course of study period for the maternity leave availed by her;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri MEKAPOTHULA SRINIVASA RAO Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners.

Having regard to the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners that the College had calculated the maternity leave of the petitioners resulting in shortage of their attendance and the examinations are scheduled to be held from 16.05.2022 onwards, the respondents are directed to receive the examination fee, issue hall tickets to the petitioners and permit them to attend the examinations.

The petitioners shall give an undertaking to the effect that they would attend the college and complete the study period. The respondents are further directed not to declare the results of the petitioners pending disposal of the writ petition. It is also made clear that till completion of the study period, the certificates of the petitioners shall be withheld.
