Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus by declaring the action of the respondent in not permitting the petitioners to writ M.D. (DVL) examination to be held from 16.05.2022 to 23.05.2022 and also practical/clinical and Viva Examination is unsustainable in law, illegal, arbitrary and consequently direct the respondent university to receive the examination fee, issue hall ticket to the petitioners and allow the petitioners to appear for the examination along with other students who are appearing for PGMD (DVL) the examination and further direct the first respondent university to declare the results as and when the results are declared for all the students by the University and permit her to complete the course of study period for the maternity leave availed by her.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the first and second respondents to allow the petitioners to pay the examination fees online, issue hall ticket and allow the petitioners to appear for the Postgraduate examination scheduled to be held from 16-05-2022 to 23-05-2022 and also practical/clinical and Viva Examinations and consequently declare the results thereafter forthwith pending disposal of WP 23108 of 2022, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dt. 29-04-2022 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri MEKAPOTHULA SRINIVASA RAO, Advocate for the Petitioners and Sri A PRABHAKAR RAO, Advocate for the Respondent Nos.1 to 3 and Smt. G. Poojitha, Advocate for the Respondent No.4, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

This Court on 29.04.2022, has passed the following order:

"The petitioners shall give an undertaking to the effect that they would attend the college and complete the study period. The respondents are further directed not to declare the results of the petitioners pending disposal of the writ petition. It is also made clear that till completion of the study period, the certificates of the petitioners shall be withheld."

The learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that pursuant to the above said order dated 29.04.2022, the petitioners have completed the Extension Study Period as required and written the exams, and has placed on record the certificates issued by the respondent No.3 evidencing the fact that the petitioners have completed the extension study period as directed by this Court.

Having regard to the above, the respondent Nos.1 and 2 are directed to release the examination results of the petitioners. That insofar as the direction to withhold the certificates of the petitioners shall stand good.
