Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring that the action of the 3rd Respondent-University, in not permitting the petitioner for physical verification of the answer script of the petitioner relating to Human Anatomy subject in respect of Hall Ticket No. 2001006095 of MBBS 1st year examination held in March, 2022, as illegal, irregular, improper arbitrary, unjust, contrary to law, violative of principles of natural justice, violative of the Fundamental Rights guaranteed under the Constitution of India and unconstitutional, and consequently direct the 3rd respondent, to produce the answer script of the petitioner relating to Physiology subject in respect of Hall Ticket No. 2001006095 of MBBS 1st year examination held in March, 2022, before this Hon'ble Court.

**Writ Petition No.27080 of 2022**

**ORDER:**

Heard Mr. Ch. Venkat Raman, learned counsel for petitioner and Mr. Prabhakar Rao, learned Standing Counsel for Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, for respondent Nos.3 and 4.

2. With the consent of both parties, the Writ Petition is disposed of at the stage of admission.

3. This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India challenging the action of 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent-University in not permitting the petitioner for physical verification of the answer script of the petitioner relating to 'Human Anatomy' subject in respect of Hall Ticket No.2001006095 of M.B.B.S. 1<sup>st</sup> Year Examination held in the month of March, 2022 as illegal, irregular, arbitrary, unjust and contrary to law; and to direct the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to produce the answer script of the petitioner relating to 'Human Anatomy' subject in respect of Hall Ticket

No.2001006095 of M.B.B.S. 1<sup>st</sup> Year Examination held in the month of March, 2022.

4. Petitioner contends that she had appeared for I-Year M.B.B.S. course examination held in the month of March, 2022 for the Academic Year 2021-22. She had successfully completed the courses of Bio-Chemistry and Physiology. But, in respect of 'Human Anatomy' subject, she secured total marks of '162' and failed in Paper-II of Theory part. She attempted almost all the questions in the said subject of 'Human Anatomy'. She secured total marks of '528' in all out of the maximum marks of '900'.

5. Petitioner further contends that after receipt of Marks Memo dated 09.05.2022, her father submitted an application *on-line* seeking re-verification of the answer script of 'Human Anatomy' subject and paid the requisite fee of Rs.200/-.

6. The 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent-University, after re-verification of the answer script, found that there was no change in the marks and confirmed that petitioner failed in the said subject, viz., 'Human Anatomy'.

10. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of with the above direction. No order as to costs.

11. As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending if any in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed.
