WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI CH SAMSON BABU presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ more in the Nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents No.4 and 5 in interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the Petitioner's property in Survey No. 47/11/1, of Jukal Village, Shamshabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy District and demolishing the compound wall and fencing without giving any Notice or opportunity despite issuance of digital pass books to the Petitioner, and entries of title reflecting in Dharani Portal as being arbitrary and illegal violating the Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondents not to interfere with the enjoyment of the peaceful possession of the lands of the Petitioner's;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri CH SAMSON BABU Advocate for the Petitioner and AGP for Revenue, who takes notice on behalf of the respondents, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 15/09/2022 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct not to interfere with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the Petitioners lands in an extent of Ac.1.21 Gts in Survey No.47/11/1, of Jukal Village, Shamshabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, pending disposal of WP No. 32627 of 2022, on the file of the High Court.

THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue takes notice on behalf of the respondents and seeks time for filing counter.

A perusal of the material on record shows that the petitioner is pattedar of land admeasuring Ac.1-21 guntas in Survey No.47/11/1, situated at Jukal Village, Shamshabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy District and the written instructions placed before this Court by the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue also shows that the name of the petitioner is shown as pattedar and also in the occupant column in the survey number S.No.47/11/1.

In view of the said admitted position, the respondents herein cannot be said to have been any claim or right over the subject land, which is a private patta land.

In the circumstances, pending further orders, there shall be interim direction, as prayed for.
