This writ petition is filed seeking the following relief:

"... to issue a Writ, Order or Direction, more so, a Writ in the nature of Mandamus, by declaring the inaction of the respondents in not filing the final report, even though, investigation is completed in Crime No.55 of 2021 on the file of P.S.Dilawarpur as arbitrary, illegal and contrary to law and consequentially to direct the respondents, to file the final report in the above crime before the Hon'ble Court as expeditiously as possible and"

2. Mr. G. Vasantha Rayudu, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that basing on the complaint given by the petitioner, Crime No.55 of 2021 is registered under Section 167, 177, 420, 120-B r/w 34 IPC on 21.08.2021. It is submitted that even after one year also, the respondent police failed to complete the investigation and file final report which made the petitioner to come before this court.

3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home on written instructions submits that as they have asked for certain information and documents from the revenue authorities and as it took some more time, they could not file the final report. Now, it is submitted that they have received the said report from the revenue authorities and within a period of (8) weeks from today, they will file final report.

4. Recording the said submission of the learned standing Assistant Government Pleader, this writ petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

The miscellaneous applications, if any shall stand automatically closed.
