WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri G ALLABAKASH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the impugned Letter No.CE/O&M/ KTPS-VII/Adm/ W.P.no.32773 /2017 and W.P.no. NO.9835 /2019 /D.NO .1323 /22 dated 18-6-2022 issued by the 3rd respondent in rejecting the claim of the petitioner for absorption though similarly situated outsourced personnel absorbed as Artisan in TSGENCO and fulfilled conditions laid in the Scheme is illegal arbitrary and violation Article 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and setaside the same consequently direct the respondents to absorb the petitioner as Artisan in TSGENCO and grant all benefits,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri G ALLABAKASH Advocate for the Petitioner and Smt.K.Udaysri, Learned Standing Counsel, who takes notice for respondents No.1 to 3, directed issue notice to the Respondent Nos.4 and 5 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
