WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI SHARAT CHANDRA A presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declare the action of the Respondents in widening the Road connecting Repaka village - Chityala village and disturbing the peaceful possessions and lives of the petitioners in Repaka Village, Regonda mandal, Jayashanker Bhupalaplli district, Telangana state without following the due process of law is illegal, arbitrary and violation article 14,15, and 21 of the constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondents not to widen the road by disturbing the Petitioners lives and dispossessing the Petitioners from their dwellings and properties without following the due process of law;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri SHARAT CHANDRA A Advocate for the Petitioners, directed issue of notice to the Respondents 8 & 9 herein, returnable in four weeks to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 04/02/2022 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2022:

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all proceedings of the Respondents in connection with the road widening, connecting the Repaka village and Chityala village, pending disposal of the WP No. 3697 of 2022, on the file of the High Court.

THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Heard Mr. A. Sharat Chandra, learned counsel for the petitioners, learned Additional Government Pleader for Revenue, for respondent nos.1 to 4, learned Government Pleader for Irrigation, for respondent no.5, Mr.M. Ramagopal Rao, learned counsel for respondent nos.6 and 7; and the learned Government Pleader for Home, for respondent no.10.

Issue notice to respondent nos.8 and 9 returnable in four (04) weeks.

Counsel for petitioners shall take out personal notice to respondent nos.8 and 9 by way of Registered Post Acknowledgment Due (R.P.A.D.) and file proof of service into the Registry.

Mr. M. Ramagopal Rao, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent nos.6 and 7, submits that out of 14 petitioners, 13 petitioners have already given consent for road widening, and seeks time to get instructions in the matter.

Status quo as on to-day shall be maintained in all respects until further orders.

Post the writ petition on 04.02.2022.
