Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in not conducting the survey of Petitioners agriculture land to an extent of Ac.0-17 guntas in Sy.No. 870 situated at Pitlam Village and Mandal, Kamareddy District as illegal arbitrary and against to the Principles of Natural Justice and consequently direct the Respondents to conduct survey in Petitioner agriculture land in Sy.No. 870 to fix meets and bound of the agriculture land considering the Petitioners F-Line application No. TTDER021900451957 dated 12/6/2019.

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for the respondents. With their consent, the present Writ Petition is being disposed of at the stage of admission.

Aggrieved by the action of the respondents in not conducting survey of the subject land situated at Pitlam Village and Mandal, Kamareddy District, in spite of her filing F-line application dated 12.06.2019, the petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition.

The learned Government Pleader for Revenue fairly stated that the respondent authorities will take necessary steps for conducting survey with respect to the subject land pursuant to the F-line application of the petitioner dated 12.06.2019, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondent authorities to complete the survey/ sub-division/demarcation of the subject land pursuant to the F-line application of the petitioner dated 12.06.2019, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of eight (8)

weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. It is needless to mention that before undertaking any survey, the authorities shall put the petitioner as well as the neighbouring landowners on notice, and take into account the work memos, if any, filed by any of the parties.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
