WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI N PRAVEEN REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the proceedings dated 06/09/2021 in file No.B/1680/2020 passed by the 3rd Respondent i.e. Revenue Divisional Officer, Narayanpet as illegal is arbitrary, illegal and without proper application of mind and done with a malafide intention and consequently direct the Respondent No.1 and 2 to re-consider the objections submitted by the Petitioners and consider proposing Bhuneed village as new Revenue Mandal;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri N PRAVEEN REDDY Advocate for the Petitioners, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2022:

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No.2 to reconsider the recommendation submitted by the 3rd Respondent dated 06/09/2021 and propose Bhuneed village as new Revenue Mandal, pending disposal of WP No. 6021 of 2022, on the file of the High Court.

THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue submitted that respondent No.2 - District Collector has already forwarded his proposals to the Chief Commissioner, Land Acquisition. However, taking into consideration two inconsistent reports dated 26.08.2021 and 06.09.2021, this Court feels it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to re-consider the recommendation submitted by respondent No.3 dated 06.09.2021 and examine the claim of the petitioners to set up Bhuneed village as new Revenue Mandal Headquarters.

Accordingly, there shall be interim direction to respondent No.2 to re-consider the recommendation submitted by respondent No.3 dated 06.09.2021 and examine the claim of the petitioners to set up Bhuneed village as new Revenue Mandal Headquarters.
