Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or orders more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Habeas Corpus to quash the detention order No.48/PD CELL/CCRB/RCKD/2021, Date.25.05.2021 passed by the Commissioner of Police, Rachakonda and the same is awaiting confirmation by the advisory board in vide G.O.Rt. No.1714, dt.31.07.2021 and the same is communicated on 07.08.2021 as illegal, arbitrary and violation of natural justice, against the detainee by directing the Respondent herein to release the detainee Ramisetty Sandhya, W/o Kommineni Sridhar, Age.32 years, R/o H. No. 2-4-817, Flat No.46, Heavenly Homes, Road No. 1 Alkapuri, LB Nagar, N/o. Gunidala, Bethel home nagar, Near Merimatha church, Vijayawada, AP. Forthwith by declaring the illegal detention of Ramisetty Sandhya, vide detention order vide No. 48/PD CELL/CCRB/RCKD/2021, Dated.25.05.2021 passed by the Commissioner of Police Chanchalguda, as illegal, arbitrary, null and void and violating the natural justice

The respondents are directed to set the *detenue*, namely Smt.Ramishetty Sandya, W/o Kommineni Sridher, at liberty forthwith, if she is no longer required in any other criminal case.
